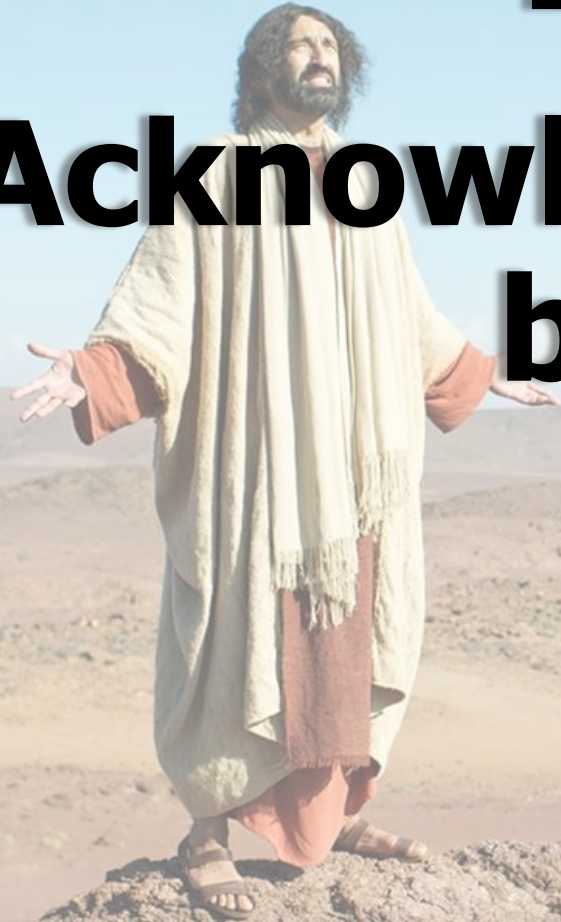

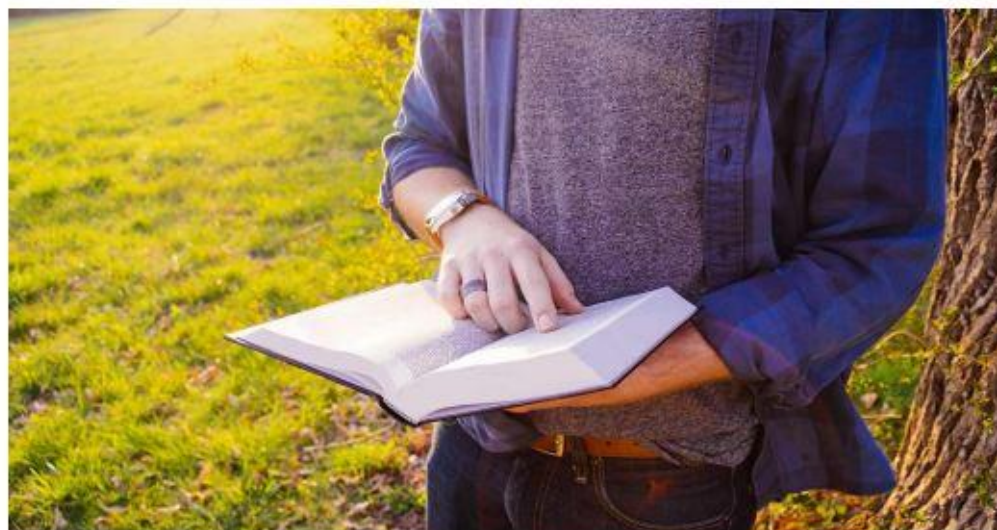

Why We Give

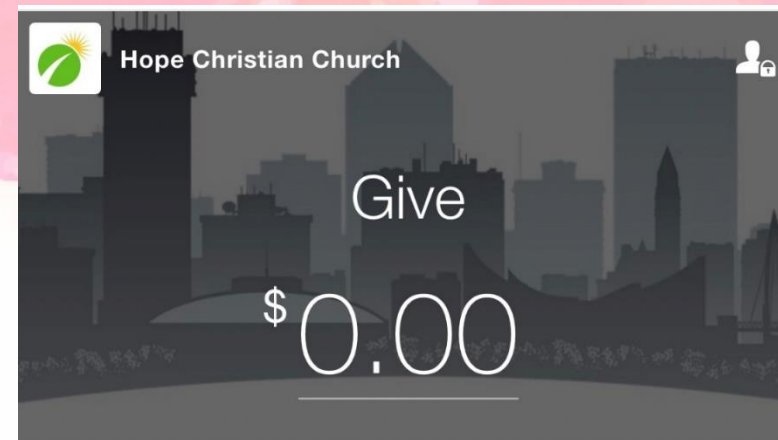
We encourage financial giving for a number of reasons:
