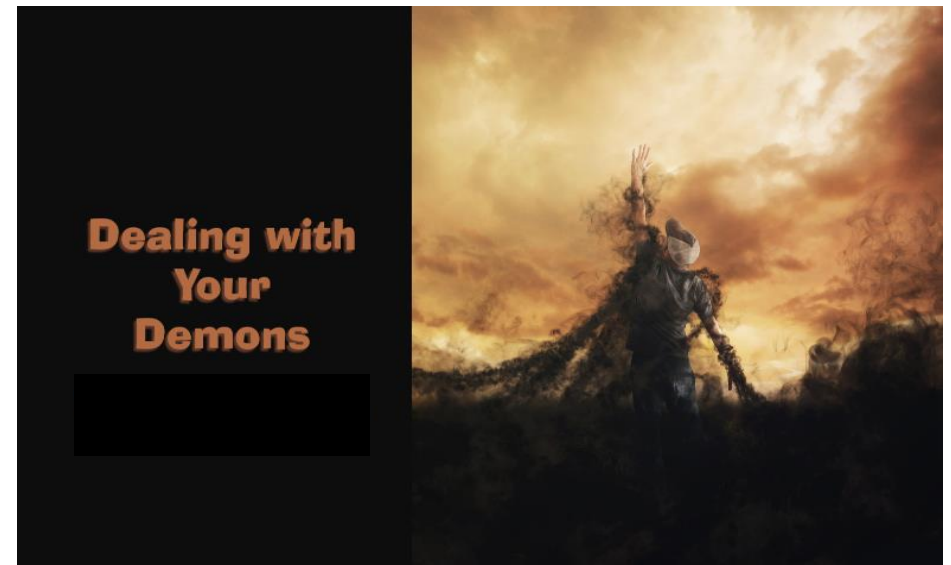

2. What strikes you most about the behavior of the demon-evil spirit?
3. The Devil is the 'Prince of Demons'; what dynamic of his character is a part of his relentless work against you? (tempter, opportunist, lover of evil, murderer, hater of truth, liar, father of lies, thief, destroyer, darkness, bondage keeper, deceiver . . .)
4. Demons work to disturb, disrupt and destroy; how have you experienced their work in your world recently?
5. Demons recognize, respond and react to the personal presence, power and authority of Jesus! How are you walking closer with Jesus this year?
6. How is Jesus' authority bringing freedom to you?
