








# Pride (+) To feel positive about oneself &/or a thing one has accomplished; 'I feel good about the job I.did'.

24 About that time Hezekiah became deathly ill. He prayed to the Lord, who healed him and gave him a miraculous sign.


### 2 Chronicles 32:24-26

# 2 Chronicles 32:24-26 So the Lord's anger came against him and against Judah and Jerusalem.


#### 2 Chronicles 32:24-26
