Warm Up: What brings you joy?

Read: Habakkuk 2:4-17

- A1. What terms or word pictures highlight the tone of this passage?
2. When you read this passage, partnered with Daniel 4:29-30, what do you sense is one of Babylon's – its King's issues?
3. In the message there were 4 Principles for Joy (that cultivate your life to be open for joy), these positive points come from negative statements. What verse(s) do you see each principle coming from?
  - 1) Peace comes from honest gain
  - 2) You will reap what you sow
  - 3) Less pressure comes with less debt
  - 4) Security is fragilely built on power, position & possessions
4. How do you see that this passage could provide joy in the midst of hardship and heartache?
5. How is 2:14 the source of Joy?
6. Reflect on and share one thing that God has done in your life recently?
7. How can becoming more aware of the Glory-presence of the Lord aid in your re-discovering Joy?
8. Prayer for the person on your right, that they can be more aware of the presence of God this week.
