Warm Up: What is your favorite "ball" game? Explain.

- **1.** Rahab is mentioned numerous times in the Bible and in nearly all of those occasions her previous profession as a prostitute is mentioned. Why do you think this is?

- 7. How is your faith helping you move toward God and trust him with what you can't clearly see?
