Warm up: What are some of your favorite phrases or quotes? Why do they mean so much to you?

1: Read Luke 15: 12-14 How many of us tried to do things our way because at the time it sounded good? Explain some instances that worked in your favor and what didn't. Did it make you stronger or weaker in your opinion?

2: Pride is a heavy burden. Is there anything in your life you just can't let go of? What have you tried to remove it?

3: Read Luke 15: 17-24 the son finally agrees to come back home and beg for forgiveness. Sometimes the hardest thing to do in life is forgive a person, allow us to be forgiven. Share a moment where you dealt with that struggle. Have you been able to move on or still caught in the moment?

4: Read 25-31 the oldest son can't wrap his head around his father forgiving his sinner brother. With the mindset of why does good things happen to bad people and bad things happen to good people. Discuss how you're able to move on knowing one day we'll all reap what we sow or get what's coming.

5: Read Proverbs 3: 5-6 and 2 Corinthians 5: 7-8 How does that make you feel that you don't have to have all the answers or the path figured out right away? The one, who knows all, is waiting for your questions and displeasures. What do you need to discuss with Him today?
